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The pronunciation of 'ed' endings of regular verbs

There are 3 different pronunciations of the 'ed' endings of regular verbs in the past and past participle forms: /d/, /t/ and /id/.
i.e.

- play becomes played and is pronounced play/d/
- watch becomes watched and is pronounced watch/t/
- end becomes ended and is pronounced end/id/

NB. The pronunciation of 'ed' is <u>never</u> /ed/!

Here are some more examples:
